Full Day Backcountry Hikes: Monday / Tuesday / Thursday

Each week we offer three distinct hiking experiences as well as easy, intermediate, and difficult hikes for every ability level!

Mountain Lakes Hikes

Every Monday, \$80 per person, ages 14+

As the glaciers that molded our mountains retreated, many left mementos of their presence in the hundreds of alpine lakes scattered throughout Colorado's Rocky Mountains. Lush sub-alpine forests & wetlands, fields of wildflowers, tumbling cascades, and of course—lunch on the shores of Vail's serene mountain lakes make this hiking experience one not to miss!

Guide's Choice Hikes

Every Tuesday \$80 per person, ages 14+

Leave the crowds behind and discover Vail's "local's favorite" trails! These Wednesday hikes offer a more relaxed & educational experience, perfect for those new to hiking in Colorado.

Alpine Summits & Passes

Every Thursday \$80 per person, ages 14+

The quintessential Colorado hiking experience climb above tree line and experience the summits & panoramic views of some of North America's highest peaks! Colorado's alpine tundra is home to some of the hardiest species on the planet, and sightings of marmots, pikas, and even mountain qoats, are not uncommon!

Well-maintained trails with a mix of steady climbs & flatter terrain,

Distance: ≤ 8 miles

Elevation gain: \leq 1,500 ft. **AND** average

grade ≤ 450 ft. per mile.



Sustained steady climbs **OR** shorter hikes

with steep grades.

Distance: ≤ 10 miles

Elevation gain: 1,500-2,500 ft.



Little to no flat hiking, mixed trail conditions, spectacular alpine views!

Distance: 8-13 miles

Elevation gain: 2,500-3,500 ft



Colorado's infamous 14,000 ft. peaks; long, steep climbs & high altitude.

Distance: Varied Elevation gain: >3,500 ft



Hikes that are either slightly longer or have slightly more elevation than the listed difficulty rating.



Half Day Backcountry Hikes: Wednesday & Sunday

Piney River Ranch Family Adventure

Wednesdays, July & August \$40 per adult, \$25 per child (8-16), ages 8+

Join a Walking Mountains Backcountry guide for a fun and educational 2 hour hike along the Piney River, followed by time to enjoy the historic Piney River Ranch. Opportunities at Piney include horseback riding, canoeing & lunch at Piney Lodge & Restaurant (added cost applies). Transportation to and from Piney from Vail & Avon is provided.

Half Day Hikes @ Vail Farmer's Market

Sundays June 15 – August \$30 per person, ages 12+

Stop by the Vail Farmer's Market & join a backcountry guide for a half day hike on our favorite local trails. Groups meet at the Walking Mountains Science Center booth at the Farmer's Market at 12:30. Transportation to and from Vail to our hikes is provided.

Fall Colors Hikes (September & October)

Full Day Hikes

Mondays & Thursdays \$80 per person, ages 14+

Our fall colors full day backcountry hikes highlight the beautiful fall foliage of the Colorado Rockies! Our early September hikes take you into the alpine zone to witness the rusty hues of autumn above tree line. During peak fall foliage (mid-September – mid October) we highlight trails that showcase Colorado's iconic Aspen forests!

Half Day Hikes

Tuesdays \$30 per person, ages 12+

Our half day fall colors hikes are perfect for families and hikers looking to enjoy Colorado's fall foliage at a more relaxed pace. These hikes take you along beautiful creek valleys through some of the most impressive aspen groves in the Vail area.
