Register to vote! Voting is important as this is a way you can speak out and use your power to vote for issues or candidates that you feel strongly about. Voting is a great way to use your voice to speak up for what you believe in. Also, be sure to vote in local municipal and general elections in addition to presidential elections.  - **Geotagging definition:** Geotagging is the process of adding geographical information to various media in the form of metadata. The data usually consists of coordinates like latitude and longitude, but may even include bearing, altitude, distance and place names. Geotagging is most commonly used for photographs

and can help people get a lot of specific information about where the picture was taken or the exact location of a friend who logged on to a service.
